Power Button	Switch console on/off

A Button	Open, confirm, continue, (riding) jump
B Button	Close, cancel, back
+ Button	Open information screens
Speaker	Play sounds, listen to birdsong
Control Stick	(On foot) Walk
Control Stick	(Riding, walkies) Move, speed up
Z Button	(Riding) Duck while saddled
- Button	Pause game, options
C Button	Display explanatory text about the game



The Information Screens

Press the **+ Button** on your **Wii Remote** to bring up the information screens. Use the **Wii Remote** to point to the arrows at the top of the screen and press the **A Button** to toggle between the individual screens.



Your Animals

This shows all the guests staying in the pens. The overview gives all the animals' names, current health values, and time remaining in the pet hotel. Point to a name and press the **A Button**. The animal's profile contains other useful information.

Toggle between different kinds of animal by pointing to the animal icons and pressing the **A Button**.



Your Storeroom

The storeroom provides a list of all items that gradually get used up. This is where you can find out how many units of food, treats and medicine, and items of jewelry you currently have in stock.

Select the categories by pointing to the buttons to the right of the list and pressing the **A Button**. Toggle between the different pen storerooms by pointing to the animal icons and pressing the **A Button**.



Your Ingredients

This is where you can find out what quantities of ingredients you have in stock. You can also see how many of your own food mixes you have in your storeroom.

Select the ingredients or prepared food mixes by pointing to the ingredient icons and pressing the **A Button**.



Your Tasks

You can use this overview screen to keep an eye on your current tasks.

Use the **Wii Remote** to point to the "Details" button and then press the **A Button**. You can then view your progress in the tasks.



Your Statistics

The statistics keep a record of your successes. You can find out here how many coins you have earned and spent, how many animals have found a home away from home with you, and how often the vet has had to be called out.

The statistics indicate everything you have done that day as well as your overall success since the start of the game.
